Text of paper, 76 mm (3in) column width, with 8 mm (.3in) space between. Use full 253 mm (10 in) column length. Paragraphs should be justified, using single spacing, with no paragraph indentation. Use Times New Roman font, 10 point. Leave one clear line between paragraphs within a section; two clear lines before a main or secondary heading.

following lines indented, Italics or underlined.*

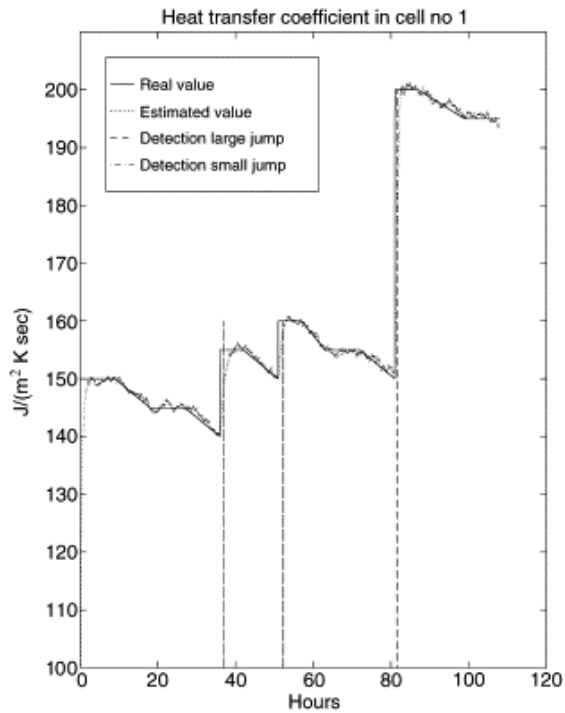


Fig. X. Title of figure, left justified, subsequent text indented. Place figures at the top or bottom of a column wherever possible, as close as possible to the first references to them in the paper. Restrict them to single-column width unless this would make them illegible. Coloured photographs or figures will not be reproduced in colour in the printed Proceedings.

Where a **publication** is referred to in the text, enclose the authors' names and the date of publication within the brackets, see (Brown, *et al.*, 1994). For one author, use author's surname and the date (Smith, 1991). For two authors, give both names and the date (Smith and Jones, 1992). For three or more authors, use the first author, plus "*et al.*", and the date (Morris, *et al.*, 1990a). If giving a list of references, separate them using semi-colons (Brown, *et al.*, 1994; Smith, 1991; Smith, and Jones, 1992; Morris, *et al.*, 1990b).

Smith, S.E. and L. Q. Jones (1972). Name of paper. *Name of journal in italics or underlined*, **Volume no in bold**, page numbers.
